**Graduate Certificate Paediatric Sleep and Respiratory Science**

The courses are offered on-line. Self study units are supported by print, on line resources and personalised tutoring.

The aim of this courses is to provide a solid foundation in the sciences underpinning the practice of Paediatric Sleep and Respiratory Science.

"These courses are aimed at a wide cross section of health professionals and will be of interest to respiratory and/or sleep scientists, physicians, general practitioners, and allied health workers who wish to improve their understanding of the scientific principles that underpin clinical measurement in these areas of paediatrics."

The next intake of the University of Western Australia's Graduate Certificates of Paediatric Respiratory Science and Paediatric Sleep Science is in July 2012. Once again UWA is offering partial scholarships to members of **recognised sleep societies** to undertake the course of their choice.
